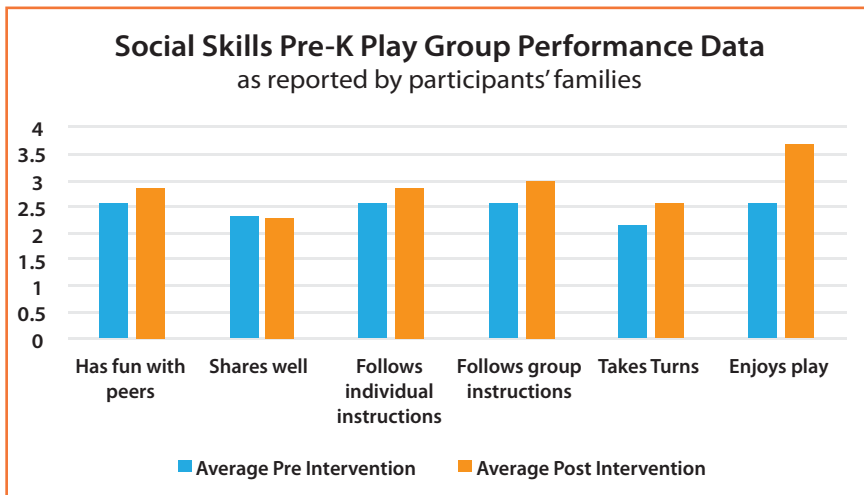
WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD LEARN?
