The group facilitator provides direct instruction on various social play skills and creates opportunities for the target learners to practice these skills within a safe, play-orientated environment. Treatment goals will be established for the entire group based on the needs of target learners. Each group is scheduled for 1 hour in duration and is organized into various activities, including turn-taking, pretend and cooperative play, and instructional games.

MUSIC THERAPY

Music therapy group is an effective and enjoyable way to capture the attention and interest of children. It is an interactive process that promotes communication, social skills, and learning. While interacting with peers and building relationships, children will participate in music making experiences including, but not limited to, movement, song writing, interactive instrument and ensemble play, and relaxation strategies. The group will focus on each child's strengths in these areas, as well as target each individual's needs.

DID YOU KNOW? By 24 months, a child can say 50 words, ask I-2 word questions, and ask for foods by name.



LUNCH & LEARN

Children ages 3-6 with sensory related feeding aversion, or "picky eating" tendencies, should join the lunch and learn group. Participants will learn appropriate mealtime behavior, effective ways to make food choices, and explore a variety of new tastes and textures that will promote a wider variety of accepted foods. This group will be led by Occupational and Speech therapy staff, and will use a combination of strategies individualized to each child's specific needs, including Food Chaining[™], Food education approach, and the SOS protocol[™].

GROWING IN THE GARDEN

Through planting and maintaining our Skill Sprout Garden, participants will practice multiple skills including motor planning, sequencing, and turn taking. Participants will be exposed to a variety of textures, temperatures, smells, and sights. This program has been specially designed for children with sensory or motor related issues between the ages of 5 and 10. They will follow instructions in small groups or pairs on the daily tasks associated with maintaining a garden.



THE ALERT SENSORY PROGRAM - NEW!

The Alert Program is a widely used curriculum with fun activities designed to help kids learn how to identify and modify their state of alertness using the analogy of a car engine. The program walks through each sensory system, with useful graphics, checklists, and personal discovery activities geared towards helping children learn strategies that will help them attend and learn. SOCIAL SKILLS THERAPY – TEEN CONNECTIONS GROUP

Assist your teenager in building relationships and developing age appropriate social skills. Our Teen Group is comprised of 3-5 target learners and a group facilitator. The group facilitator provides direct instruction on social topics in adolescence and creates opportunities for the target learners to practice these skills within a safe, therapeutic environment. Treatment goals will be established for the entire group based on the individual needs of the target learners, although focus will be on common social issues during adolescence. Each group is scheduled for approximately one hour and is structured to include instructional learning time on social topics and natural group interactions.

SOCIAL SKILLS THERAPY – POSITIVE PEERS

We want to help your teenager with special needs understand social rules and boundaries, develop friendships, and actively participate in the community! Our social skills program pairs your adolescent child with 1-3 volunteer peer role models to provide an engaging and natural therapeutic environment. Peer volunteers reinforce social concepts by modeling age-appropriate social skills and providing direct opportunities to practice targeted skills. In-session social activities are often conversational in nature, require perspective-taking and compromise, and help prepare your teenager for real world social experiences through role-playing scenarios.



LIFE SKILLS BOOT CAMP FOR ADOLESCENTS

As parents, we want to see our older children learn to succeed as adults. Enroll your teenager now and ward off "failure to launch"! Life Skills Boot Camp for Adolescents is a 2-week program designed to boost your child's independence in self-care skills and higher level activities of daily living. The class will be led by occupational therapy staff. The curriculum will be an intense focus on the key areas of function that are critical for adolescents to master as they move into adulthood, including: simple meal preparation, grocery shopping, cleaning, following an alarm and setting reminders, safety awareness, leisure skill development, self-care, and healthy living. The topics will be presented in a fun, engaging group atmosphere with elements of specific instruction and activities designed to apply the information. Pre-enrollment screening may be required.

Therapy sessions, with a master's level mental health professional, can be conducted with the individual child, the entire family, or solely with parents and/or siblings, depending on your family's needs and priorities.
